Minutes

MOTION: Jeff moved to accept the minutes of April 27 and May 1 as written. Unanimous.

Highway Update

Dave gave an update on the highway bids for FY18. He's decided that we really should do milling and paving on Greenfield Rd. instead of the micro-surfacing. If we do the micro-surfacing, we won't be actually gaining anything as far as the structures are concerned. We should go ahead and mill, pave, and raise the structures; and then, maybe micro-surface the next time around. Also, with the price of blacktop this year, we won't be ahead cost-wise by micro-surfacing. After further discussion, all agreed that we should use Lane to mill and pave.`

MOTION: Jeff moved that we have Lane mill and pave Greenfield Road. Unanimous.

Jeff suggested that Dave think about oil and stone for East Hill Rd. Discussion. All agreed that this would be a good project for Spring 2018.

ATM Warrant Review

The Board reviewed the Warrant and discussed appropriate motions.

Fire Dept. Expense Account

The Board discussed the Fire Department's expense account and agreed that, even with the Reserve Transfer of \$3500, there will still need to be more funds transferred with the Finance Committee's approval. They asked Bob to ask Tracey for recommendations.

Police Dept. Update

Dan said that he has a new recruit for Officer for the Department. His name is Steve Curtis, and he feels that he would be a good addition to the Department.

MOTION: Jeff moved to appoint Steve Curtis to the Police Department as Officer, with a six month probationary period. Unanimous.

Columbus Day Weekend

Dan said he would like to hold a 5K Run on the Saturday of the Columbus Day weekend, and an Antique Tractor Run on that Sunday. Discussion. Dan will provide more information and the route later.
