This is the 75-year anniversary of the Leyden church cafeteria at the Franklin County Fair. Starting in September 1936, a tent was used for a booth with horseshoe kegs used for seats. Now 75 years later we have a building with tables and chairs to seat about 70 people at a time. We still use the same clam chowder and beef stew recipes that were used the first year. In addition, we now serve breakfast, hamburgs, hotdogs, lunch specials, dinner specials, homemade baked beans, sandwiches w/ pickles and chips, shortcakes, pies, and more.

Only through the efforts of many people have we been able to keep our little white church on the hill fair booth open. This is an opportunity to meet your neighbors, have a good time, share your talents, and raise funds for the church, a good percentage of which goes back to the community through services and projects.

We have already started to take donations of non-perishable items (there is a list in the church Fellowship Hall and Town Hall). We will be looking for breads, pies, and desserts to be made. If you would like to help with the baking, please contact Valerie Snow at 772-0924.




