Meeting Called to Order at 7:00pm

East Hill Road Conditions

Kelly Rosazza expressed concern about the expense of replacing gravel, continual grading, and drainage work trying to maintain East Hill Rd. David explained the use of Chapter 90 funds and the strategy for keeping the roads in shape. All agreed that it would be nice to pave the road, but we are financially limited without increasing taxes. David explained that he tries to do one road project a year, with approximately \$10,000 if available, at the end of the fiscal year, rotating to different areas of Town.

Highway Dept. Update

David reported that delivery for the new body for the 1998 dump truck has been delayed due to the steel shortage. He's hoping to have delivery by December 1, in time for snow plowing. The new Ford F550 should be delivered by September 29. The plow and body are at Vassar's, and the truck should be ready by mid-October. He also reported that he is not planning on any traffic counts this year. Paving of West Leyden Rd. from Brattleboro Rd. to Mid County Rd. is scheduled for August 24, and line painting is scheduled for August 29.
