Preliminaries

Reviewed correspondence

- MACC bill due: \$99; corrected to include Janell instead of Rich; signed
- Beth Kuzeba wrote about logging in Bernardston -- not in our jurisdiction. State Circuit Rider said they have a logging plan

Discussion

Penfield Conservation Restriction

- Under a recreation/open space restriction, can't build a house or make a commercial use
 - Will probably build a storage shed
- Temporary bridge under jurisdiction of ConCom
- Pennfields want to build a new, permanent bridge, that we need to approve
 - Over a wetland, extra requirements
 - Want a culvert, but can't interrupt flow or destroy the streambed
 - May be easier to have a trussed bridge, needs to be stabilized
 - We may need to inspect the wetland, would advise them to get a wetlands specialist

184 West Leyden Rd RDA

Landowner John Duffy

- Not all the wetlands were flagged. Need to know where the 100 and 200 feet buffers (the latter for a perennial stream)
- Naturalist ID'ed a "known wetland" that does not appear on state site
- Can't complete until we have a map with <u>all</u> wetlands identified; attach photos
 - Also must be physically flagged
- Our response will be an Order of Conditions
- Can either do a logging plan or work through ConCom
- We will do a site visit
- Chris drove through wetland, we may require remediation via planting
- We're allowing piled logs to be removed; they weren't in the wetlands

Solar bylaw

- State has comments that we haven't seen
- Approved by Attorney General, deleting provisions on battery storage facility prohibitions and prohibition on the use of herbicides,

FRCOG project to map Green River corridor

- Email from FRCOG
- FRCOG applying for planning grant
- Asked whether ConCom wants to participate
- Unclear whether ConCom would get any benefit out of attending; deferring decision

Knotweed Grants

- Try for mowing grant
