Erica Jensen and David Pomerantz are Leyden's co-EMD'S. They are guests of the BOH to explain expectations of BOH in event of town emergency.

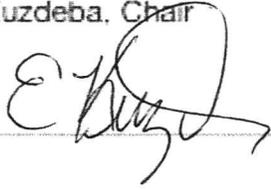
Main points: They drafted a Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP)
This template is now with MEMA. Mr. Marsden is our MEMA regional rep
After MEMA signs off, Leyden Selectboard must sign off on this.
CEMP deals with a shelter plan, animal care plan, COOP-continuity of operations planning, SOP
BOH will work with EMD/SB/COA to coordinate with the MVP that identified town weaknesses with roads, flooding...etc
Erica and Dave gave the BOH a list. We will go over this with Randy. He will let us know what is expected of us vs FRCOG.
FRCOG received a \$400,000 grant, this will be used to improve emergency preparedness . Dave and Erica will see how this impacts Leyden. Our Health Agents will work in conjunction with BOH/EMD. Our town buildings do not currently qualify as shelters but instead are warming/cooling centers.
Transportation depends on severity of event.
Beth will forward CEMP to Marcia and Jerry.
Beth has been working to finish a Needs Assessment Survey that the EMD will use with the town to assess preparedness of town departments and also individual households in the event of a 3 day shelter in place.

2. Minutes from BOH meeting on 12/6/22 were approved with motion from Marcia and second from Beth. Jerry was not present at that meeting.
3. BOH budget will not change. Stipends for members and working budget will remain at.... Stipends .800 Chair, \$600/ member. Working budget \$1000.
Jerry suggested mounting Naloxone box to outside of town offices.
Beth motioned for Jerry Lund to address Selectboard to mount a Rescue Kit to outside of town offices with possibility of ARPA funds covering the cost. Marcia with second and unanimous vote.
Another suggestion was for Neighborhood Captains formed through EMD to have naloxone on hand
4. Randy explained at this time all phases of PHE grant that have been sent out, have been answered by Health Agents. BOH will participate in future phases.
5. Tobacco regs will be addressed at next meeting.
6. Well water/septic pumping records are getting organized
7. Beth had a question on plans getting sent to BOH with no address.

9-1-1 coordinator (fire chief) assigns address to new property according to map and lot
8. Next meeting 2/7/23 at 7pm at town offices

Meeting adjourned at 8:32pm with motion from Marcia and second from Jerry.
