On 3/1/2022, the Board of Health voted to remove the mask mandate in Leyden, EFFECTIVE 3/7/2022 for public buildings for fully vaccinated people. Unvaccinated people must still wear a mask in Leyden's public buildings. We still strongly recommend wearing masks in indoor public spaces for those fully vaccinated.

This decision is based on the present decreasing rate of PCR confirmed Covid cases, the decreasing hospitalizations from COVID, and current state and CDC guidelines.

Please feel free to continue to wear a mask inside if you are fully vaccinated and feel more comfortable doing so. If you are elderly, have a child under the age of 5 or any unvaccinated child in your home, or are immune compromised the Board along with the CDC and State recommend wearing a mask in indoor public spaces.
