

**Town of Leyden**  
**Invitation for Bid – USED Rapid Attack/Mini Pumper Fire Truck**

Sealed bids for delivery of one USED Fire Truck Apparatus, as detailed in attached specifications, or equal, will be received by the Town of Leyden, Massachusetts, at the Leyden Town office Building on or before Tuesday, February 20, 2024 at 9:00 AM at which time they will be opened and publicly read by the Leyden Select Board. The Town Coordinator's clock shall be the sole determining factor of time.

The Town of Leyden is the awarding authority and reserves the right to determine what is "equal" if "or equal" components or services are proposed. In the event Leyden Town Office Building is officially closed for weather or emergency, the bid will be opened the next open day at the same time. Specifications are available only through the Town of Leyden website ([www.townofleyden.com](http://www.townofleyden.com)) in order for all recipients to be notified of any addenda or deadline changes.

This bid is being undertaken under MGL Chapter 30B. All bidders shall be familiar with the law's requirements.

Any questions pertaining to the bid requirements or documents should be directed, in writing, to Michele Giarusso, Town Coordinator/Chief Procurement Officer, Town of Leyden. Written responses will be emailed to all bidders on record who have requested the IFB from the town.

Any addenda must be acknowledged on the Bid Price Form. Failure to do so may result in rejection of bid. If you received this bid form from any other source than the Town of Leyden, you must register to receive any addenda.

Bids should be placed in a sealed envelope marked "USED LEYDEN FIRE TRUCK– SEALED BID" in the lower left-hand corner and hand delivered or mailed to the Leyden Town Offices. No faxed or emailed bids will be accepted. If requested, a receipt indicating this date and time will be given to any bidder delivering a bid in person. A bidder may correct, modify, or withdraw a bid by written notice received by the Town of Leyden prior to the time and date set for the bid opening. Bid Modifications must be submitted in a sealed envelope clearly labeled "Modification No...." Each modification must be numbered in sequence and must reference the original IFB. After the bid opening, a bidder may not change any provision of the bid in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the Town or fair competition. Minor informalities will be waived or the bidder will be allowed to correct them. If a mistake and the intended bid are clearly evident on the face of the bid document, the mistake will be corrected to reflect the intended correct bid, and the bidder will be notified in writing; the bidder may not withdraw the bid. A bidder may withdraw a bid if a mistake is clearly evident on the face of the bid document, but the intended correct bid is not similarly evident.

All bids must be accompanied by the Bid Price Form with Bid Signature Page/Corporate Authorization which includes a Certification of Tax Compliance/Non-Collusion, Affidavit of Compliance, Tax Identification Number, executed by an authorized agent of the bidder. Any bid that does not include this document, fully completed, will automatically be deemed non-responsive and will not be considered.

Additional material may be included with the bid. Any or all Bids may be accepted or rejected as the Town determines is the best interest of the public.

The sealed bid should include the entire Invitation for Bids Package so that no pages requiring acknowledgement will be forgotten.

Each bidder must submit one (1) original and one (1) copy of their bid

## **Spec sheet for proposed 4×4 Quick Attack (used)**

**This bid is per Massachusetts General Law Ch30(b).**

**The Town of Leyden has the right to accept or reject any bid as they deem in the public's best interest.**

### **Purposes:**

- Primary purpose is first on-scene mini pumper / quick attack vehicle
- Secondary purpose is as a wildland firefighting vehicle
- Third purpose is as rescue vehicle

**Use in conjunction with other apparatus and departments.** This first on-scene engine will be followed by LFD Tanker 1 and rely on mutual aid tanker shuttle for continued operations.

- High Clearance, 4x4 capability and a shorter wheelbase will provide access where other larger vehicles can not.
- This vehicle will provide additional mutual aid for wildland firefighting.

### **SPECIFICATIONS**

**Required specifications are noted with an asterisk (\*)**

#### **Condition:**

- Model year must be 2000 or newer.
- The vehicle will be in overall good/excellent condition with no mechanical defects. The vehicle will have complete and verifiable service records. The paint, body and interior will have only minor (if any) blemishes. There will be little or no rust on this vehicle. The pump and any other mechanical features must be fully functional and have been regularly serviced.\*
- There will be no more than 80,000 original miles on the odometer.\*
- The pump will have no more than 200 hours

#### **Pump:**

- Minimum 500 US gal/min\*
- Pump priming system\*
- Pump and roll (if available)
- 4" or 6" suction inlet\*

#### **Discharges:**

- Discharge 2.5 or 3"\*
- 2" deck monitor
- 100-200ft booster reel
- Crosslay discharge hose – 1.5" or 1.75"\*
- Foam system discharge to crosslays and deck gun (if included)

#### **Tank:**

- Minimum 250 US gal water\*
- Foam 15 US gal\*

- Tank to pump and pump to tank refill capability\*

- Wheelbase – 205” or less. This depends on clearance and fore and aft overhang\*

**Overhead clearance:**

- Highest point of vehicle (tank empty, unloaded with movable equipment) may not exceed 108 inches (9 ft) from base of fully inflated tire.\*

- One (1) 24’ two-section solid beam, aluminum ladder
