In addition, you may be eligible for **SNAP** (formerly known as "food stamps"), which provides cash for groceries for low-income individuals and families. To see if you qualify, please contact **Food Bank of Western Massachusetts' SNAP Department at (413)992-6204**. Households that receive SNAP are also eligible for HIP, which provides extra money for fresh produce each month.
