

THE TOWN OF LEYDEN'S COMMUNITY CHOICE POWER SUPPLY PROGRAM

Already Enrolled with Eversource Green Options through Green Energy Consumer Alliance?

Consumers who are already enrolled in a renewable energy program with Eversource, through Green Energy Consumer Alliance, should receive a notification letter (for automatic enrollment) and they should be enrolled in the Town's Program unless they choose to opt-out. Participation in the Town's Program will not affect their participation in Eversource's Green Options program.

Already Enrolled with a Third-Party Supplier?

If a consumer doesn't receive a notification letter (for automatic enrollment), it's because their account wasn't eligible at the time of mailing (e.g. enrolled with a third-party supplier) and they will not be AUTOMATICALLY enrolled in the Town's Program. However, everyone in Town is eligible to join the Program. They should instead receive an informational postcard and may opt-in at any time. The only caveat is some (not all) suppliers have a termination fee for leaving their contract early. It is recommended that anyone with a third-party supplier call that supplier to confirm there isn't an exit fee before they join the Town's Program. The Town wouldn't want someone to join the aggregation and then find out they were hit with a substantial termination fee.

To join Leyden's Program, you can do one of two things:

1. Visit colonialpowergroup.com/leyden and click the OPT-IN button, then fill out and submit the Opt-In Form.
2. Call First Point at (888) 875-1711 and ask to join the Town of Leyden's Program.

For both of the above options, you should have your Eversource bill handy in order to provide some required information. Enrollments can only be processed on meter reads so it may take one or two billing cycles before taking effect.

What are the Town's product offerings?

Standard Product: Meets MA renewable energy requirements. This product is being offered at \$0.12952 per kWh for 32 months (March 2026 to November 2028).

Optional Green 10 Product: Provides 10% MA Class I Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) above the state's then-current requirement for these renewables [30% in 2026; 33% in 2027; 36% in 2028]. This product is being offered at \$0.13312 per kWh for 32 months (March 2026 to November 2028).

Optional Green Product: 100% renewable, provides 31% MA Class I RECs above the state's then-current minimum requirement for renewables [69% in 2026]. This product is being offered at \$0.14068 per kWh for 32 months (March 2026 to November 2028).

Basic Service rates change twice a year or more, depending on rate class. As a result, the aggregation rate may not always be lower than the Basic Service rate. The goal of the aggregation is to deliver savings over the life of the Program against Eversource Basic Service. However, future savings cannot be guaranteed.
